**About the Speaker**

**Robert J. Resnick, Ph.D., ABPP**, is a health/clinical psychologist and a recently “retired” Professor of Psychiatry and Pediatrics, Virginia Commonwealth University. In 1984, he developed and directed, until his departure, the Attention Deficit Disorders Clinic. He is now a Professor of Psychology at Randolph-Macon College and maintains a specialty practice in Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorders through the life span.

Dr. Resnick has been the recipient of many awards for contributions to professional practice including the Board of Professional Affairs, American Psychological Association (APA) Award for contributions to practice; APA Division 12 award for contributions to professional practice; the Lee Salk Award from the Society of Pediatric Psychology; and

the Outstanding Civilian Service Medal from the Department of Army. He is a Diplomate in Clinical Psychology and a Distinguished Practitioner in the National Academy Practice. He serves on the editorial boards of several journals and has presented and published widely on health policy and attentional deficits. In 1995-1996, Dr. Resnick was the President of the American Psychological Association. He is, currently, the President of Division of Psychotherapy (29) and a past-president of the APA Division of Independent Practice (42). Dr. Resnick is a past-member of the professional advisory board of Children and Adults with Attention Deficit Disorder (CHADD) and is a member of the advisory board of Celltech Pharmaceuticals. His book, The Hidden Disorder: A Clinician's Guide to Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder in Adults was recently published. Dr. Resnick has had more than a 25 year interest in attention deficits and their impact on individuals' lives; beginning with his son, Steven, a lifetime member of that "club."
